



School Contribution

School Year 2026–2027

Each family's contribution makes it possible to sustain and develop the educational project of Escolasofia and to make Waldorf Education accessible to as many children and families as possible.

Annual Registration and Materials Fee

The annual registration and materials fee must be paid by all students to reserve their place for the school year. It includes basic school materials and school insurance.

For the grades it does not include the cost of reading books, flute or educational trips.

The registration fee is non-refundable even if the student does not ultimately take the place.

Contribution by Stage

* Early Childhood includes a daily organic snack.

Payment Options

Monthly payment: between the 1st and the 5th of each month, from September 2026 to June 2027.

Annual payment: single payment before July 1st, 2026, with a 5% discount.

Sibling Discount

A 15% discount applies for siblings (does not apply to the first student) on annual registration and materials fee and school tuition.



Optional Services

Lunch service (organic catering):

- 175 € → December, February, April and June
- 195 € → January
- 210 € → September, October, November, March and May
- 15 € occasional lunch day
- 9 € occasional menu for Secondary students (no supervision)

Afternoon care:

- 90 € / month
- 9 € / day

Payment Conditions

- All payments are non-refundable.
- Monthly fees must be paid between the 1st and 5th of each month.
- Returned bank receipts will incur the corresponding bank charges.

Annual Fee Review

School fees may be reviewed annually taking into account the sustainability needs of the educational project.
